WORK EXPERIENCE OPPORTUNITIES

Inside Operations

- Perform point of sales for golf and merchandise using Jonas Software.
- Assist the Merchandiser with day-to-day retail operations such as merchandise displays.
- Gain an understanding of MembersFirst Tee Sheet Software and accurately charge and track golf rounds on three golf courses in a high-paced operation that generates close to 55,000 annual rounds.
- Work closely with the Caddie Manager to ensure all caddie requests are serviced.

Outside Operations

- Interact with members and guests from around the world.
- Work closely with the Outside Operations Manager to ensure proper opening and closing procedures are completed for the practice facility, bag room and cart barn.
- Experience the Golf Learning Center with the opportunity to shadow Club Fitters and Teaching Professionals.

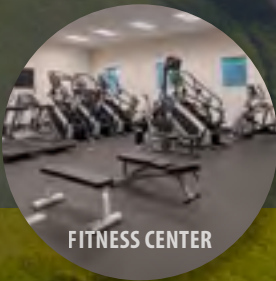

EAGLEWOOD RESORT & SPA

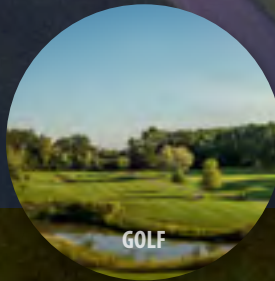

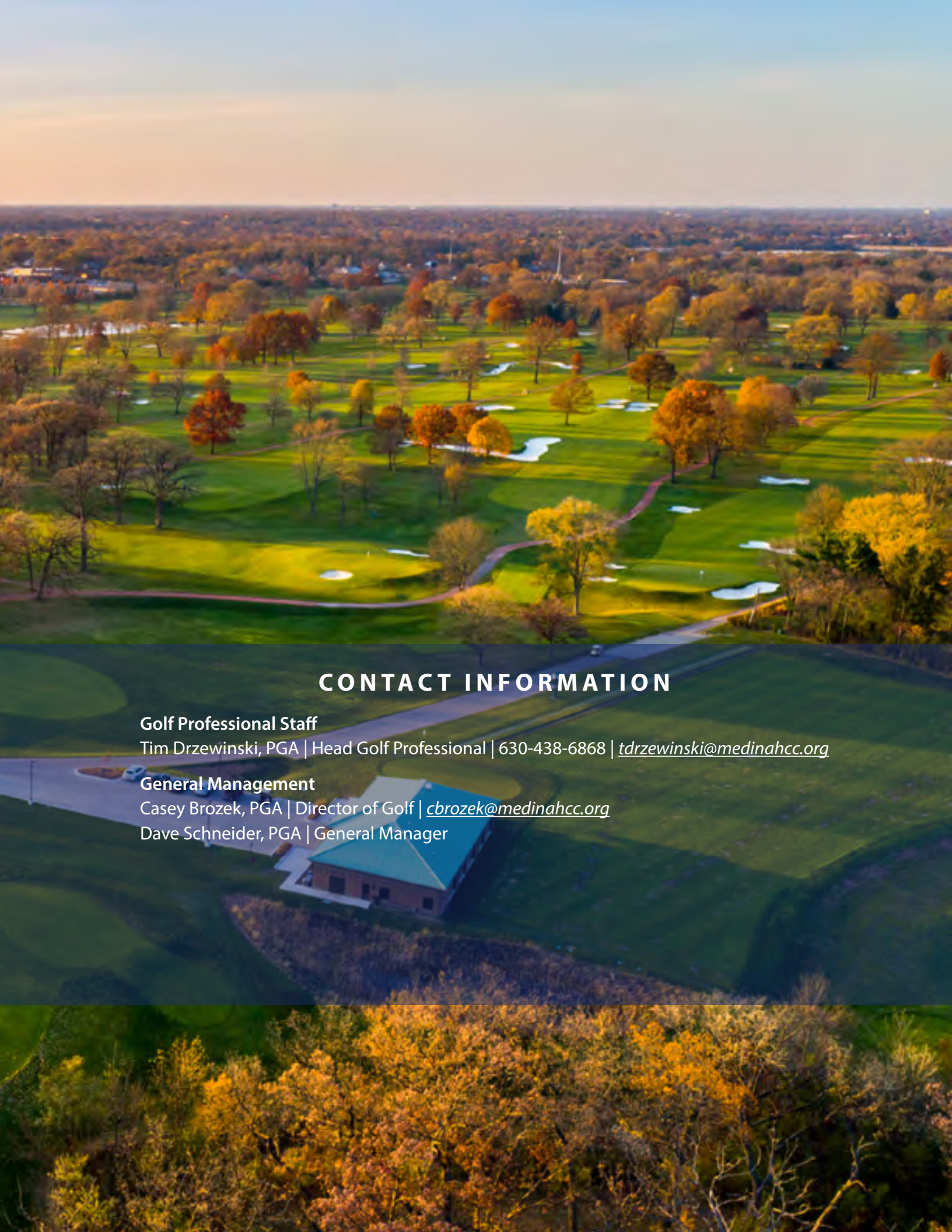


WELCOME TO CHICAGO
